

Frequently asked questions for CVSC

What are the pool hours?

The scheduled hours, with weather permitting is:

Friday June 19th – 5pm to 9pm

After this date, with weather permitting is:

Sunday to Friday – 12pm to 9 pm

Saturday – 12pm to 10 pm

Dates for September will be modified once school opens and will be posted

- Please note that the pool does close early to host board approved events such as B Swim Meets and pool socials. Advanced notification is posted at the pool, on the website calendar, Facebook and texted to you if you have signed up for these options.
- Main pool and wading pool closes 15 minutes prior to club closing

What is the check-in procedure when I walk into the club?

Each family member must check in at the checker's booth and show their membership card. The staff will not keep your card. You must show it to gain entry to the Club each time you enter.

Why are membership cards different colors?

The different colors allow our checkers to see if a member is entering the club who is under the age of 16 since there are supervision restrictions.

What are the membership colors?

- Green (adults 16+ years of age)
- Yellow (children 12 – 15 years of age)
- Pink (children under 12 years of age)
- Blue (summer houseguests and child-sitters)

- Summer houseguests are a person who resides in the member's family home for the summer but whose permanent legal address is different. The sponsoring member must accompany the houseguest to the club.
- Child-sitters are sponsored by a member's family and will be admitted to the club only while supervising and caring for the member's children.

What age can my child be at the pool by himself/herself?

- Children 12 – 15 years of age shall be permitted without an parent or adult member
- Children 10-11 years of age may be sponsored by a sibling (same membership number) who is 14 years of age or older, on a one to one basis

Can I bring a guest?

Yes. Members may sponsor guests by registering them at the checker's booth and paying the appropriate guest fee.

What are the guest fees?

- Adult guest pass (ages 16 and over) - \$7.00
- Children (15 and under) - \$5.00
- Senior Citizens (65 years +) - \$2.00
- Evenings after 5pm - \$3.00 for all adults and children

The sponsoring member must accompany all their guests. If the sponsoring member leaves the club, the sponsored guests must also leave. Members shall at all times, be held responsible for the actions of their guests.

How many times can a Cherry Hill resident be a guest?

Guests residing in Cherry Hill are permitted as guests a maximum of five (5) times during the pool season (May 2015 –September 2015)

- **Grandparents are allowed unlimited visits**

Who can sponsor guests?

Members who are 16 years or older can sponsor guests

What if my guest is a member at another Cherry Hill swim club?

Guest members are **not limited** in the amount of their guest privileges provided that they can show proper identification acknowledging their current membership at another Cherry Hill swim club.

Can I have a party at the pool?

Yes. You must fill out a party reservation form from either the checker's booth or the manager on duty. Reservations are accepted on a first-come first-serve basis. You will be contacted by a pool representative to confirm your reservation. Please give at least one week notice to allow for proper employee coverage and availability.

Is alcohol allowed at the club:

Yes. Drinking of alcoholic beverages on the grounds of the club shall be limited to club members and guests who meet the New Jersey Alcohol and Beverage Commission regulations pertaining to possession and consumption of alcohol. Appropriate ID will be required to be shown on request. Offenders may have pool privileges revoked for a period of time determined by the manager and the Board of Trustees.

Can I bring glass or glass containers to the club:

No. Glass containers and glass bottles are prohibited on the club grounds. All drinks and/or food must be in plastic containers. All coolers will be checked upon entering the club to ensure the safety of our members and guests.

Are swim diapers permitted in the main pool?

No. Children who are not fully toilet trained are not permitted in the main pool.

Is there a lap lane designated for swimming during pool hours?

Yes. The main pool has one lap lane intended for the serious swimming of consecutive laps. There will be a maximum of 2 swimmers in the lap lane at any one time. This activity is open to all members and guests.

Can my child use a PFD (Personal Floatation Device) in the main pool?

Yes. PFD's may be used by a child under 48" provided that the parent or legal guardian is in the pool no deeper than shoulder high within arm's reach of the child. **The pool manager reserves the right to disallow the use of PFD's based upon pool use at the time or other safety reasons.** The parent or legal guardian assumes all responsibility while the child is using the PFD.

What is required for a swim band test?

Children under the age of 14 who want to use the 5ft area of the main pool & the well area must complete a band test.

The band test for the 5ft area consists of:

- Swimming 2 pool laps (1 lap of freestyle & 1 lap of your choice)
- **MUST BE A RECOGNIZABLE STROKE**
- tread water for 1 minute

The band test for the well area consists of:

- Swimming 4 pool laps (2 lap of freestyle & 2 laps of your choice)
- **MUST BE A RECOGNIZABLE STROKE**
- tread water for 2 minute

How much does a swim band cost?

The cost of a swim band is \$1.00. Replacement bands can be obtained for \$2.00 for each replacement.

What if my child forgot his/her swim band?

Any child forgetting and/or losing his/her swim band will be confined to the 3 ft. section of the main pool or a replacement band can be purchased.
